



ELAC Meeting Minutes

November 06, 2018

1. WELCOME: ELAC vice-chair Esmeralda Gonzalez called the meeting to order at 9:00am and welcomed the attendees.
2. APPROVAL OF AGENDA: ELAC vice-chair Esmeralda Gonzalez called motion to approve the agenda, Eliazar Valenzuela approved the motion. Yadira Herrera seconded the motion. All in favor.
3. APPROVAL OF SEPTEMBER MINUTES: ELAC vice-chair Esmeralda Gonzalez called motion to approve the meeting minutes, ELAC chair Katia Padilla approved the motion. Maricela Elizalde seconded the motion. All in favor.

5. DELAC REPORT: Maricela Elizalde gives summary of the report:

6. THE IMPORTANCE OF REGULAR ATTENDENCE BY Mrs. Anna Sanchez: Ana Sanchez is a Health Specialist. She tells us that the tendency to attend generates more income per child and that it is a fundamental part both academically and in discipline. Absences have had an impact of 10% during this school year. She explained that the absences are justified, if the mother or father calls in advance to notify the school or send a doctor's note. There are also unjustified absences that will be handled with a phone call the first time and the case is pending if so, by the 3rd absence the school sends a letter to setup a meeting with the Principal for both parents to sign a contract to improve the issue.
7. ORAL COMMUNICATIONS: Ivette Baptist from PTA joins to invite us to Art & Craft classes in room 507, to volunteer in teaching Spanish and to volunteer in fundraising. She explains the great economic impact that PTA represents to the school and how to help them. Yadira Herrera shares her experience at Mini-CABE 2018 and talks about the importance of attending school meetings as well as district meetings.
