February 19th, 2019

1. Welcome: ELAC President Katia Padilla calls to order at 9:07 am, and welcomes the attendees.
2. DELAC Report: The president of ELAC Katia Padilla says that there are approximately 29,600 students in our district of which 34% of them are English learners.
3. ELPAC and Thought Exchange: Our principal, Mr. Shy, explains and provides information about the local district for fundraising and account replenishment, providing his district's goal of improving and increasing access for students and their families to support emotional well-being, social and physical. It provides the actions and services explaining to if the funds allocated for each one of them. The District will hire and retain first class employees to support students and their families, ensuring equitable access to services and supports in the system it generates; technology, buildings and facilities, services for students including health services and hiring of highly trained teachers. Students in all grade levels will get better results on District and State tests. Thought Exchange, the community intelligence platform that allows leaders to build trust, make better decisions and humanize the communication experience. It will take place from March 1 to 15, 2019.
