He also announced we will return to 100% in person instruction for 2021-2022 school year. They will also have a “Virtual Academy” in our District for those who wish to continue with Distance Learning. We will receive a survey about this matter in about 2 weeks.

Local Control and Accountability Plan: Information: LCAP IN ACTION: the CVESD community will work to ensure that ALL students, including English learners, students with disabilities and designated target groups, show measurable growth, which will lead to reducing the achievement gap in literacy and mathematics.
